What Is the SAP Data Catalog?

The SAP Data Catalog provides detailed descriptions, or metadata, of confidential federal data assets that are available for discovery on the SAP portal. You can use the catalog as a virtual roadmap to show you how and where to access information relevant to your research interests and view information on data collection, data coverage, where data can be accessed, and more.

How to Search for Metadata

Search for a keyword

There are three ways to search for metadata in the SAP Data Catalog:

► By keyword

- Enter text into the search box and select the magnifying glass icon.

► By topic

- Select the “topic” icon and a range of subjects will appear at the bottom of the screen. Select a topic to view information related to the topic.

► By agency

- Select the “agency” icon. The names of the 16 federal statistical agencies and units participating in the SAP will appear at the bottom of the page. Select an agency to view results.

Metadata: Identification and Summary

National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey (NHANES) Genetic Restricted Data

Description ⓘ
DNA samples were collected in the **Third National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey (NHANES III; 1988-1994)** and in subsequent NHANES cycles (1999-2002, 2007-2008, 2009-2010, and 2011-2012). The program is a nationally representative collection of stored DNA samples and genetic data and will serve to add to the extensive amount of health, nutritional, and environmental information collected from NHANES. Resulting genetic variants are deposited into the NHANES Genetic Data Repository. These datasets are categorized as restricted data since they contain identifiable information.
