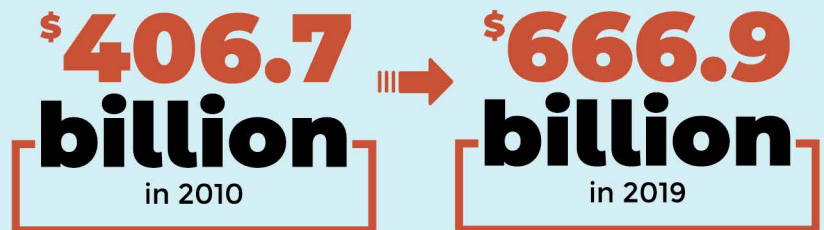

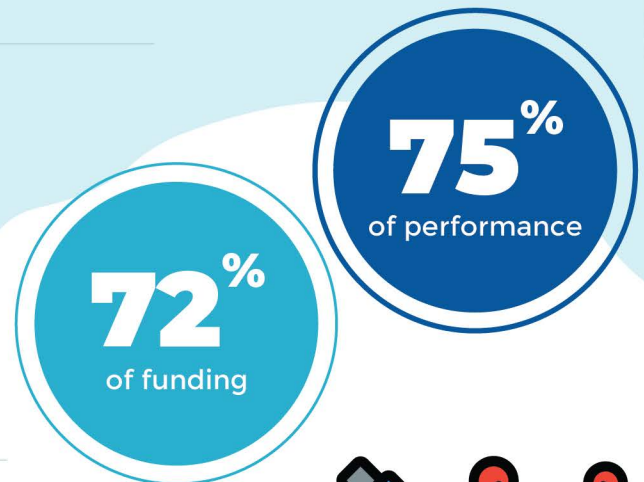
Overall U.S. R&D performance

Continued to grow over the past decade



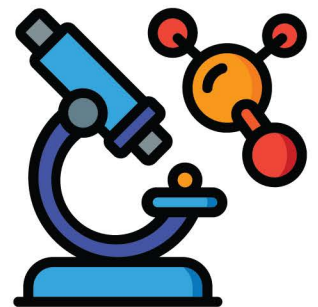
Sector-level R&D performance and funding
