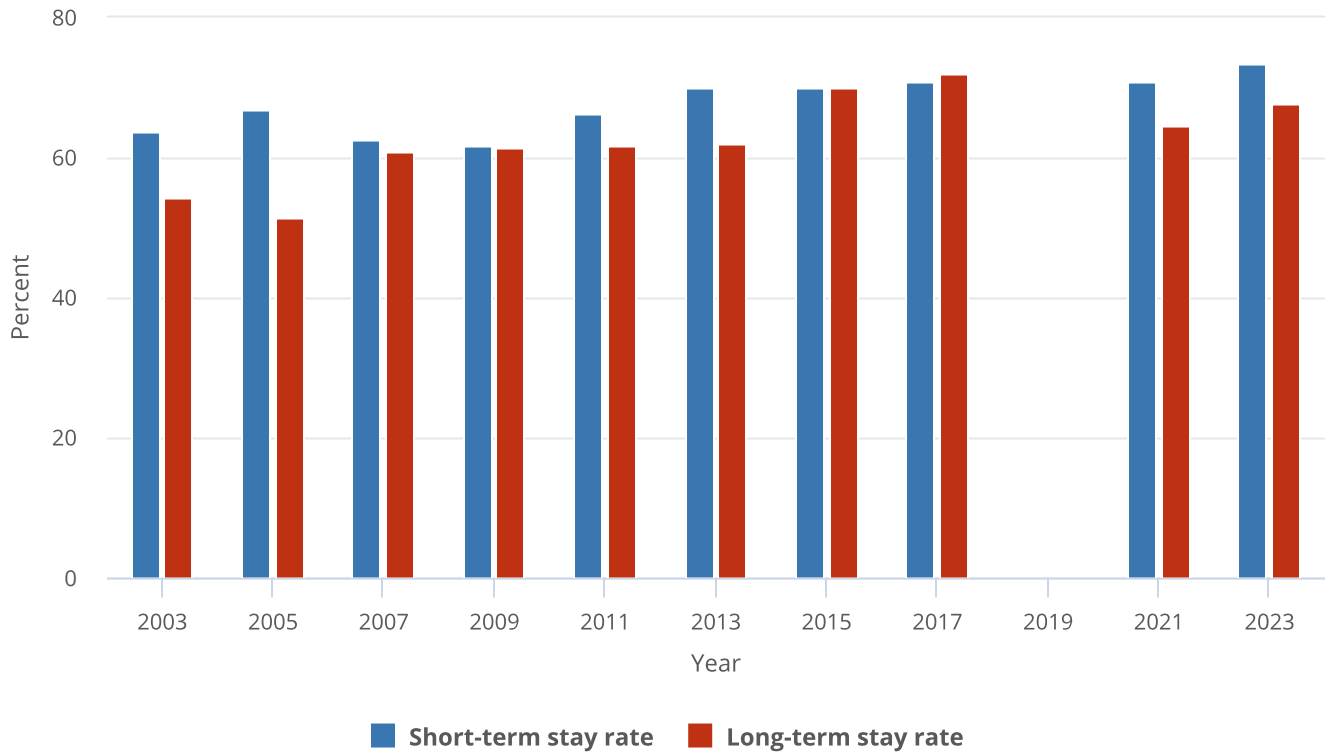


Figure TAL-44. Stay rates for U.S. S&E doctoral degree recipients with temporary visas at graduation: 2003–23
