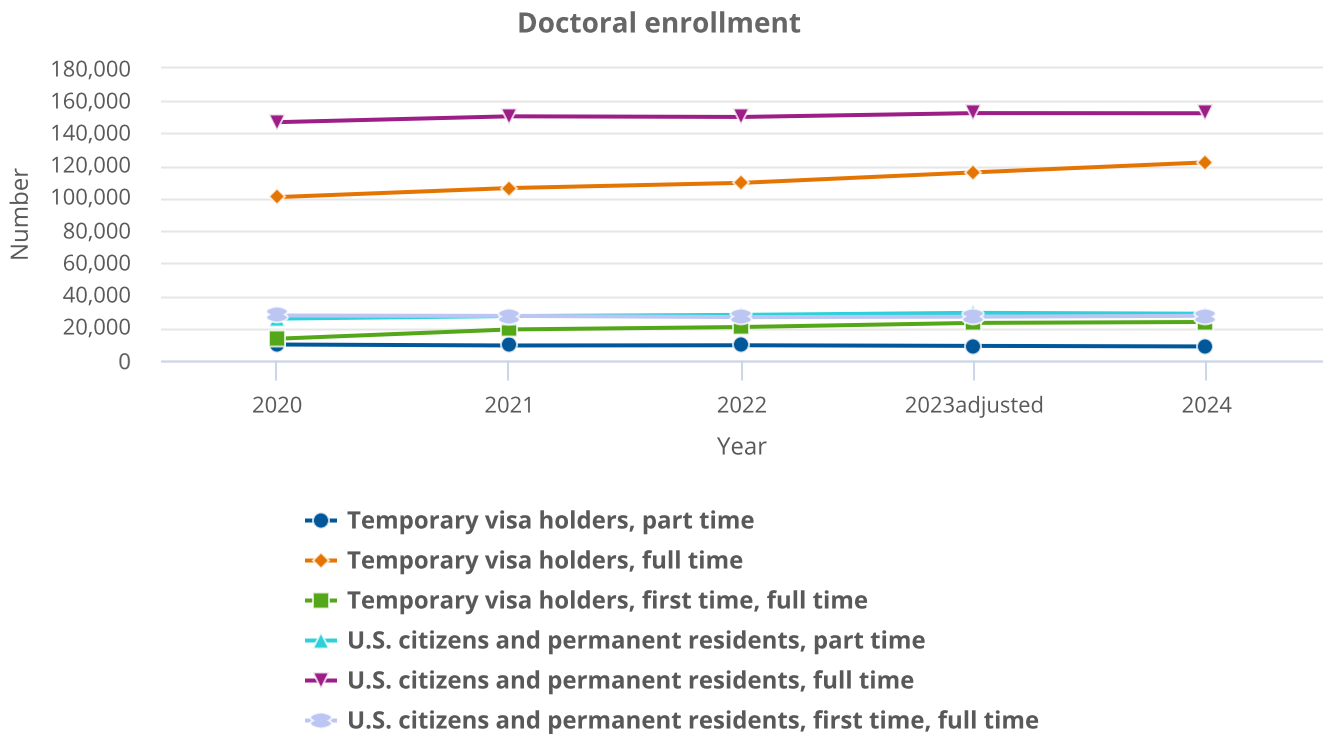
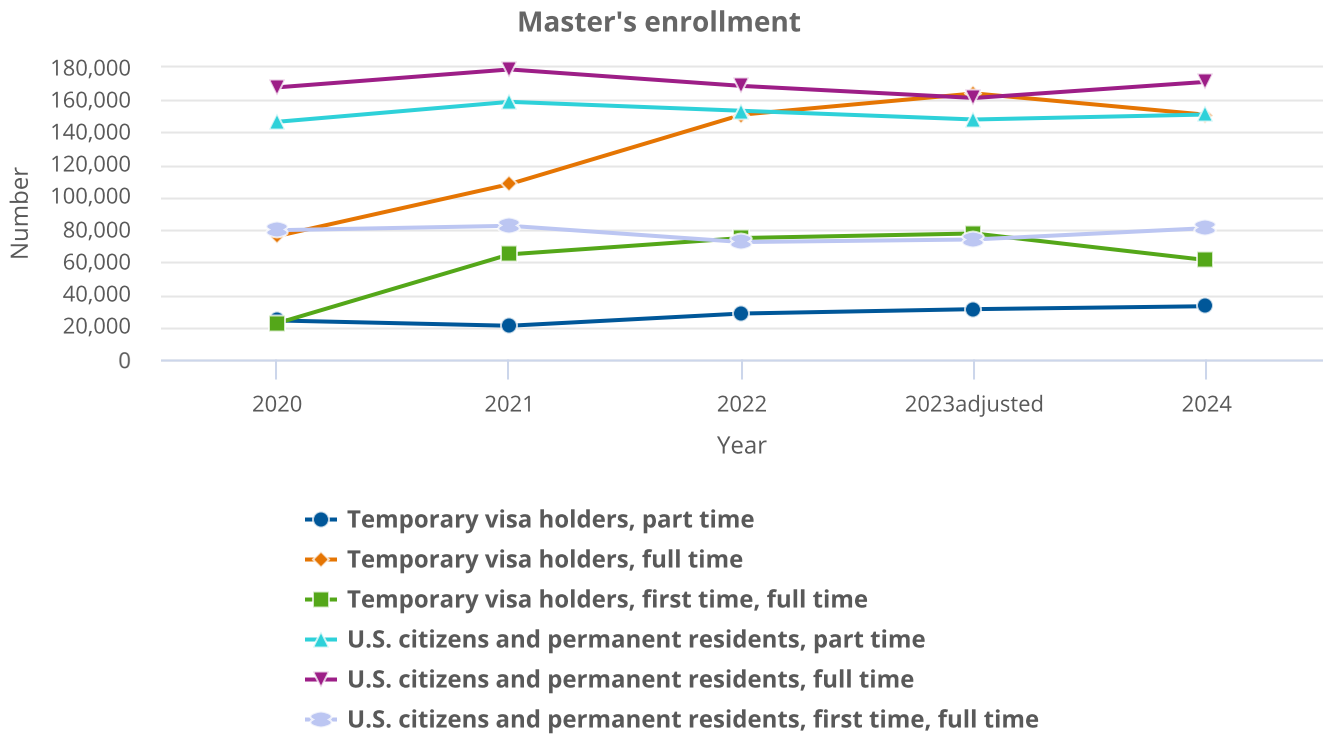


Figure 2. Enrollment of master's and doctoral students in science, engineering, and health fields, by citizenship status and enrollment type: 2020–24
